Catholic Home Missions Collection to be taken Feb. 29-March 1

The Catholic Home Missions Collection will be taken in the diocese Feb. 29-March 1 to help strengthen and fortify dioceses in the United States that are unable to provide pastoral services without assistance from resources other than their own. SACRAMENTS

Baptism:

All arrangements, including confirmation of the date, must be made with the parish office.

Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Sponsors, if married, must either be married in the Church or with the Church's permission. Parents must attend Baptismal Preparation, which is regularly scheduled throughout the year.

Marriage:

Arrangements must be made directly with the pastor at least 6 months before the date of the wedding. Marriage preparation is required and couples are asked to speak to the priest first before setting a date. Couples, rather than parents, should contact the priest. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Because of growing concerns about the impact of the flu, the Sign of Peace at Mass will be exchanged without the normal handshake or kiss. When the priest asks you to exchange the sign of peace during this Mass and until further notice, simply turn to the person next to you, and without contact, say "Peace be with you". If you have a cold or suspect you may have something contagious, please refrain from receiving from the cup.
