## SECOND COLLECTION

The Knights of Columbus will take up a second collection the weekend of January 18/19, 2020 in support of Vocations to the Priesthood and Diaconate. The diocese continues to need more resources for their formation. Please be as generous as you can.

## SACRAMENTS

### Baptism:

All arrangements, including confirmation of the date, must be made with the parish office.

Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Sponsors, if married, must either be married in the Church or with the Church's permission. Parents must attend Baptismal Preparation, which is regularly scheduled throughout the year.

### Marriage:

Arrangements must be made directly with the pastor at least 6 months before the date of the wedding. Marriage preparation is required and couples are asked to speak to the priest first before setting a date. Couples, rather than parents, should contact the priest. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

## Regarding Clearance Renewal

Most ministers and volunteers will need to renew their clearances in a few months. Please check the dates on your Criminal History, Child Abuse and volunteer affidavit and begin the process as soon as you can so that you receive your new clearances before the expiration date. If you initially paid for them, you can renew now as a volunteer (free of charge) but if you obtained them free when you initially applied, you must wait a full 57 months before you apply again. Affidavits are available in each worship site and in the parish office. If you do not have your original paperwork, please call the parish office for the date you are due. You do not have to take the Virtus, Protecting God's Children or the PA Mandated Reporter sessions again. To obtain your child abuse and criminal history, visit the diocesan website, scroll to the "obtain your PA clearances". ## Scheduling Masses

Due to the time it takes to schedule Masses, please kindly adhere to the rules set forth on the back of the Mass Intention Request form. No Masses will be scheduled over the phone. All requests **MUST BE** submitted on the proper form and may be mailed to the parish office or dropped off in the offertory basket to the parish secretary's attention. You may drop the form off at the office, but the Mass will not be scheduled at the same time that you come into the office. When bringing the Masses to the parish office, the Masses will be scheduled in the order they were received and on a first come, first served basis. A \$10 stipend is requested for each Mass scheduled. Every effort is made to accommodate the requested date, if it is not available, then the date closest to it will be scheduled. We will not call to verify the date. This policy is in place to be fair to everyone so that the majority get the date requested. Please also know that schedules sometimes have to be rearranged due to diocesan meetings and/or conferences that the priest must attend. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
