SACRAMENTS

Baptism:

All arrangements, including confirmation of the date, must be made with the parish office.

Sponsors must provide proof of eligibility by a letter from their respective pastors, must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation. Sponsors, if married, must either be married in the Church or with the Church's permission. Parents must attend Baptismal Preparation, which is regularly scheduled throughout the year.

Marriage:

Arrangements must be made directly with the pastor at least 6 months before the date of the wedding. Marriage preparation is required and couples are asked to speak to the priest first before setting a date. Couples, rather than parents, should contact the priest. If either party was previously married, an annulment must be granted prior to the selection of a future wedding date.

Cultivating a Grateful Heart

All students in grades K-7 recently received offertory envelopes for 2020. How does giving our offerings show God we're thankful He meets our needs? We are giving back to God; we are giving extra money to help others. There is also space on each envelope to record your time (are we generous with our time to someone in need) and talents..you could even draw a picture showing how you are giving back to God in other ways. Our goal is not to bring in money; our goal is to teach children to be givers. Giving to God is a core value of our faith..we know that everything we have comes from Him. The amount is not as important as the intentional giving....thanking God for everything He gives us.

A thought...One approach to helping children understand the value of money is by using "Money Jars." Give your child three jars and label them "Money to Save," "Money to Send," and "Money for God." If you give your child two dollars as an allowance, pay them in quarters..then they could divide the money into the different jars...one way to teach them to be intentional about how they use their money. Regarding Clearance Renewal

Most ministers and volunteers will need to renew their clearances in a few months. Please check the dates on your Criminal History, Child Abuse and volunteer affidavit and begin the process as soon as you can so that you receive your new clearances before the expiration date. If you initially paid for them, you can renew now as a volunteer (free of charge) but if you obtained them free when you initially applied, you must wait a full 57 months before you apply again. Affidavits are available in each worship site and in the parish office. If you do not have your original paperwork, please call the parish office for the date you are due. You do not have to take the Virtus, Protecting God's Children or the PA Mandated Reporter sessions again. To obtain your child abuse and criminal history, visit the diocesan website, scroll to the "obtain your PA clearances". The easiest way to obtain your clearances is online.
